

# **ON FRIDAY'S Commencing 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021**

**(BUT Dependant on the Club's Schedule)**

Every Friday will be a Stableford Qualifying Competition off the Yellow T unless stated otherwise

It will be based on your YES response to an invite to play

You will receive an invite to play on the Sunday or Monday in the same week prior to the Friday roll up. You will be requested to respond by 9pm on the Wednesday of that week.

We have been limited to 10 T times (5 off each the First and the 10<sup>th</sup> T) so the Roll Up will for a maximum of 40 players. It will therefore be based on First Come/First Served

A random draw will be made on the Wednesday evening after 9pm or on the Thursday Morning

The Start Sheet will be sent out on the Thursday ready for you to come and play at your allotted T time on the Friday.

As the T times are OURS there will be no need for advanced bookings or Team captains

Our First T time will be 08.00 from both Ts

Our wrap-around times are 2 hours dead to complete the front nine and 2 hours 20 minutes to complete the back nine. For those commencing on the 10<sup>th</sup> YOU HAVE TO BE on the 1<sup>st</sup> T within 2 hours 20 mins of your start Time or you will interfere with all T time bookings that are following you.

You will have to get a stamped card from the Pro-Shop before commencement of your round.

You will need your card verified by another player in your group.

Please enter your Card via the Club Website either on your personal device or the Club Computer in the Spike bar

The results (and prizes allotted to your electronic "banking") will come to you via the Club Office notification email following the "signing off" of the competition by the Club office

The cost of the Friday Qualifiers will be a £1.00 entry fee and will be recorded by Nigel within your electronic "banking"

The prizes will be	£16.00 First Place
	£ 8.00 Second Place (if attendee numbers allow)
	£ 4.00 Third Place (if attendee numbers allow)
	£ Balance to the Captains Charity.

These amounts will be subject to review as and when average roll up numbers can be established.

For the purposes of Prizes, a roll up of less than 17 people will not be considered an official roll up and therefore there will be no entry fee and no prizes– It will, however, continue to be a Stableford Qualifier regardless of the numbers involved and cards will need to be entered via the club computer or your own device.
